

From the Pastor's Pen



ecently Don Lemon and his guest on a recent CNN newscast lampooned southerners as ignorant buffoons with a hick accent. Perhaps our southern idiosyncrasies are offensive to the rest of the planet and explains the hostilities and ridicule we sometimes experience from others. I suppose our warm weather, delicious southern cookin', friendly neighbors, and our easy ways seem peculiar to the intellectual cosmopolitan. All I can think to say to Don Lemon is "bless his heart."

As I vented through my emotions I could not help but draw a parallel between Mr. Lemon's attitude toward southerners and the world's attitude toward the church. The minimum amount to be awarded to each approved applicant is \$1,000.00.




Applications are now being accepted for the Mary Atmar Johnson Scholarship through Tidelands Hospice Founda-

Applications are available in the church office and must be completed and returned to the Foundation by Monday, March 9, 2020






